

Bio

Hector Santos is a stone mason, sculptor, and graphic designer in Vermont. He grew up in Northampton, Massachusetts, and moved to a commune in the Turners Falls/ Gill area when he was eleven. The commune was alive with art, design, music and construction. He couldn't help but get involved and took his first carpentry job at fifteen where he was introduced to masonry, then stone masonry. He was instantly hooked on what would become a lifelong passion. He was also called into service to drive Rock & Roll tour busses around the country where he worked for bands such as: The Scorpions, Billy Squire, David Gilmore, and Waysted who opened for Motley Crüe and Ozzy Ozbourne.

His work as a stone mason and sculptor has great success and been recognized on television and in the media. Bob Vila has featured Santos's stone walls on the popular television series, "Home Again," and his wall sculptures have been shown on Home and Garden Television's "That's Clever." When the markets crashed in 2008, Santos returned to school to study Graphic Design to supplement the typically quiet months for stone masonry work. He learned Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, and HTML. His works as a Graphic Designer are inspired by the Vermont landscape, architecture, food, and sports. In the spring of 2010 he self-published his first book, The Modern Stone Age, The Stone Work of Hector Santos.

Winter is traditionally a tough time for stone masons and as a result, Hector has sought refuge working in the warm surroundings of restaurants wearing every hat from waiter to chef. An entrepreneur at heart, Santos has also owned an art gallery, a skateboard company, taught cross-country skiing, tried organic farming, and delivered sorbet by van to New York City.


His works as a Graphic Designer are inspired by the Vermont landscape, architecture, food, and sports.








